MONTHLY REPORTS:

CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER:

Jenny Wilkinson explained that this is Child Abuse Prevention month. There was a kickoff event yesterday at Riverbend Family Ministry. The 440 paper cutouts lining the halls represent children they have interviewed in 2025. There will be more events for the community on April 23rd and April 30th to help raise awareness

CIRCUIT CLERK:

Patrick McRae explained that they are looking to renegotiate with their case management provider. He added that case files have picked up as spring is always a busy season. Missy Bickmore is his new Chief Deputy and today marks her 25th year of employment with the county.

CIRCUIT COURT:

Judge Threlkeld stated that they have filled the position of Executive Assistant. He added that today is the 30th anniversary of drug court and there was a graduation ceremony.

DETENTION HOME:

Chief Deputy Wessell explained that in the month of March they started with 18 minors and admitted 22 for a total of 40. 24 were released during the month. The average out of county minors is 8. Their mental health professional conducted 23 suicide screenings and downgraded 2 minors from high risk to medium risk, and no one upgraded. She did 22 thinking reports and 46 counseling sessions. She also provided 2 mental health training sessions for their staff.

PROBATION:

Director McKee stated that they had their drug court graduation ceremony today with 14 graduates. 11 of those are what they call redeploy, which means they are a foot out of prison and chose to be part of the program to get clean and sober. He mentioned it costs approximately \$52,000.00 per year to incarcerate an individual and about \$5,000.00 per year to go through their program. In their program they get counseling, job skills, parenting skills and get better. There are approximately 3,500 individuals on probation in Madison County. He added that Todd Hansel has been an asset to the program and will be retiring next month.

PUBLIC DEFENDER:

Mary Copeland stated that they have a heavy case load and still need additional staff. Mental Health continues to be the top challenge with their clients and there is a lack of mental health resources. The wait time for individuals who have been remanded to the Department of Human Services is long.

SHERIFF/JAIL POPULATION: No report

STATE'S ATTORNEY:

Ali Foley explained that for the month of March they received approximately 399 felony referrals from various law enforcement agencies. They issued 310 felony cases, 42 petitions to detain were filed, 35 hearings were held and 29 individuals were detained in the month of March as well.

Mr. Holliday moved, seconded by Mr. Schulte, to adjourn the meeting at 3:46 PM. *MOTION CARRIED.*
