MONTHLY REPORTS:

DETENTION HOME:

Jeff Seaman gave the following numbers for the month of June:

Juveniles in custody on first day of month: 34 (30 males and 4 females)

Average population: 22

Average stay: 58 days

Average age: 16

Out of county borders: 4

Juveniles released during month: 15

PROBATION:

Kevin McKee reported that earlier in the month they received information from the Administrative Office regarding their reimbursement for 2027 and they advised them that they will receive full funding for 2027 to include call increases. They also requested and were awarded additional funding for the redeploy Illinois Grant.

He gave the following numbers for the month of May:

Individuals currently on probation: 3,276. (3,177 adults and 174 juveniles)

Field services unit completed 901 office & community contacts

High-risk offices completed 23 home contacts

Pretrial services completed 1,468 criminal histories

Supervising 98 individuals on pre-trial release

Individuals on electronic monitoring: 22 (19 adults 3 juveniles)

Individuals in problem solving court: 101

Individuals in drug court: 61

Individuals in veteran's court: 23

Individuals in mental health court: 17

PUBLIC DEFENDER:

Mary Copeland stated that there were 887 felony cases set today and her office represented 550 of those. They have 10 full time attorneys including her and 4 part-time. She recently added another attorney, Abigail Miller, to her staff and one additional support staff employee.

SHERIFF/JAIL POPULATION:

Captain Hernandez reported that as of today there are 241 detainees in custody. Of those, 233 are felonies and 8 misdemeanors. There are 7 detainees scheduled to be transported to IDOC and 10 that have been deemed unfit and remanded to DHS. The highest population in June was 287. The maximum housing capacity is 306. They have processed 2,228 detainees' year to date.

STATE'S ATTORNEY:

Ali Foley stated that in the month of June they received 290 felony referrals and filed 302 felony charges. They filed 39 petitions to detain, 29 were argued at hearings and 18 defendants were held. Year to date they have filed 1,568 felonies and received over 2,000 felony referrals.

Mr. Petrillo moved, seconded by Mr. Schulte, to adjourn the meeting at 3:35 PM. *MOTION CARRIED.*
