Section 34.12 Cooperative Joint Purchasing

procurement units and open-ended state public procurement unit contracts, which are made available to other public procurement units.

Justification: ILSAAP is necessary because they handle all criminal appeals and post-conviction cases for the State's Attorney's Office. They keep our office compliant with appellate deadlines, and provide back-up when we have conflicts or complex cases.

Section 34.08 Purchases **Exempt from Competitive Sealed Bidding** (A) a) There is only one source for the required goods, service, or construction item.

Despite the exemptions, competitive pricing shall be encouraged and /or cost or price analysis.

After a good faith review...forward an exemption request to the Purchasing Director...who will review and approve all exemption requests...a written determination for the basis of the bid exemption shall be made by the Purchasing Director and included in the contract file.
