 - a. Two All-Band Consolettes for the City of Highland, IL
Vendor: Reimbursement to the City of Highland
Amount: \$15,312.76

Description: Reimbursement to the City of Highland for Consolidation.

Justification: With the consolidation of the Highland PSAP into the Madison County Sheriff's PSAP, Highland needed a way to communicate with their police and fire departments for non-911 type calls back to Madison County. Due to Highland being on a different radio system at the time of the consolidation, it was necessary for the ETSB to purchase radios that were compatible with the Sheriff's Office. Additionally, this allowed Highland to utilize their older system as a back-up if the new radios or radio system failed. This purchase has been fully funded by the

FY25 Consolidation Grant, that we received in 2026. This payment will reimburse the City of Highland for their purchase. No ETSB, nor General Funds are being used for this purchase.

Description: All PSAPs in Madison County do not utilize the same CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) system.

Justification: : All PSAPs in Madison County do not utilize the same CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) system. 5 PSAPs use Tyler – New World, and the 2 remaining use IDS Applications – Lawman. With everyone, police and fire, transitioning to the Starcom21 Radio Network to share information and communicator more effectively, we thought it prudent to share information via CAD systems as well. This purchase allows for IDS Applications to conduct backend work that will allow their system to talk more directly with the Tyler system. Thus, allowing the sharing of information in real time throughout Madison County. This purchase is being paid for by the FY 25 Next Generation 911 Grant, that we received in 2026. No ETSB, nor General Funds are being used for this purchase.
