EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT:

George Koranyi reported that they have transitioned from a summer program to a winter program. They had 5 rehab callouts that were all structure fire related. UCP had 2 callouts. Illinois Law Enforcement has received a grant within the last five months for the Unified Command Post which means they will pay for the mechanical overhaul of their command post in the amount of \$13,811.27. This will pay for vehicle maintenance so it will not come out of EMA budget.

911/ETSB:

911 Director Weber reported that the text to 911 system is now up and running. This is only to be used if one is unable to call. For example, a hearing or speech-impaired person or if someone is with a person who they believe may harm them. This is currently only available in English.
